AIM OF THE COURSE / TARGET GROUP

This course provides participants with the required skills and knowledge to enable them to use quick cut saws in a safe and proficient manner in the workplace. Individuals will learn how to inspect, safely operate and carry out basic saw maintenance, including mixing fuels, air filter cleaning and blade change. The course is aligned to the of Code of Practise for Concrete and Masonry Cutting and Drilling which outlines the procedures that should be followed when using a quick cut saw and addresses the nationally recognized unit RIISAM204D Operate small plant and equipment. This course is suitable for any individual.

The expected learning outcomes are that the trainee: -

1. Understands the regulations and safety requirements related to the use of quick cut saws.
2. Prepares for use and maintains the saw to prescribed standards.
3. Use safe, efficient techniques.
