Safe Quick Cut Saw Operation



AIM OF THE COURSE

The aim of this training is to impart to participants the necessary knowledge and skills to equip them to use cut quick saws in a safe and proficient manner in the workplace. Students will learn how to inspect, safely operate and carry out basic saw maintenance, including mixing fuels, air filter cleaning and blade change.

The course is aligned to the of **Code of Practise for Concrete and Masonry Cutting and Drilling** which outlines the procedures that should be followed when using a quick cut saw and addresses the nationally recognized unit **RIISAM204A Operate small plant and equipment**.

The expected learning outcomes are that the trainee: -

1. Understands the regulations and safety requirements related to the use of cut quick saws.
2. Prepares for use and maintains the saw to prescribed standards.
3. Use safe, efficient techniques.

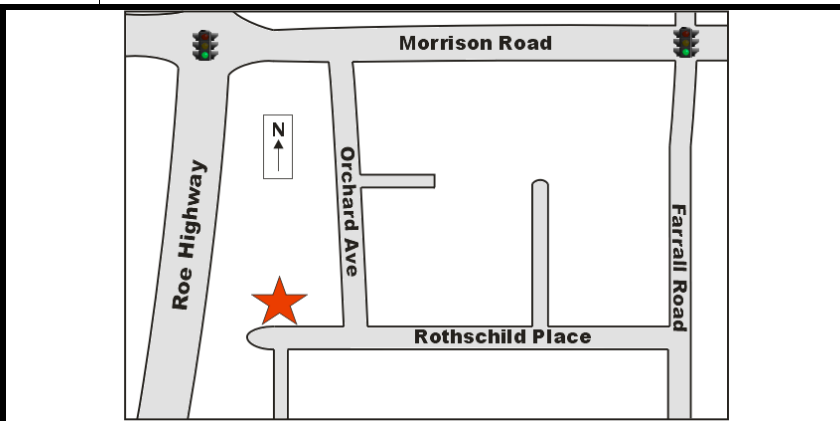
