WHAT IS THIS COURSE ABOUT?

RII31609 - Certificate III in Trenchless Technology reflects the role of a skilled employee in Civil Construction operations who carries out horizontal drilling and boring operations for the installation and repair of services.

DELIVERY STRATEGY

The certificate is delivered by Australian Training Management (ATM) in partnership with Vermeer WAT & NT. ATM delivers the independent civil construction competencies and Vermeer WAT & NT delivers the trenchless technology specific competencies. ATM will also coordinate applications, signups and government and BCITF subsidy arrangements on your behalf.

ATM and Vermeer WAT & NT will independently coordinate delivery timetables and present Statements of Attainment identifying competencies obtained under their programming to successful candidates. ATM will present the final *Certificate III in Trenchless Technology* for participants that complete all of the required competences listed below.

To obtain this qualification you will require 26 units in total including 18 core and 8 electives. The units of a typical *Certificate III in Trenchless Technology* qualification is presented below.
