CERTIFICATE III in DRILLING OPERATIONS

WHAT IS THIS COURSE ABOUT?

RII31809 - Certificate III in Drilling Operations reflects the role of employees such as drillers who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications applied in a wide variety of contexts, which may involve application of some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

DELIVERY STRATEGY

The certificate is delivered by Australian Training Management (ATM) in partnership with Vermeer WAT & NT. ATM delivers the common trade competencies and Vermeer WAT & NT delivers the drilling operations specific competencies. ATM will also coordinate applications, signups and government and CTF subsidy arrangements, where applicable, on your behalf.

ATM and Vermeer WAT & NT will independently coordinate delivery timetables and present Statements of Attainment identifying competencies obtained under their programming to successful candidates. ATM will present the final *Certificate III in Drilling Operations* for participants that complete all of the required competences listed below.

To obtain this qualification you will require 13 units in total including 8 core and 5 electives. The units available for a typical *Certificate III in Drilling Operations* qualification are presented below.
