What is this traineeship about?

CPC20120 Certificate II in Construction is a nationally recognised qualification that provides an occupational outcome and a range of support tasks applicable to a majority of construction work sites.

To obtain this qualification you will require:

- 10 core units of competency
- 5 elective units (1 elective may be substituted from a relevant endorsed Training Package)

The selection of typical traineeship units is presented below.

Core Units – 10 units required

CPCCCM2005	Use construction tools and equipment
CPCCCM2006	Apply basic levelling procedures
CPCCCO2013	Carry out concreting to simple forms
CPCCOM1012	Work effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
CPCCOM1014	Conduct workplace communication
CPCCOM1015	Carry out measurements and calculations
CPCCOM2001	Read and interpret plans and specifications
CPCCOM1013	Plan and organise work
CPCCWHS2001	Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
CPCCCM2012	Work safely at heights

Elective Units – 5 units required

To be selected and agreed by RTO, employer and trainee at time of enrolment.

How is the course delivered?

This course is available by Australian Training Management as a registered traineeship qualification enrolled by an employer only.

Participants who are employed either full-time or part-time for a minimum of 20 hours per week are eligible for this traineeship.

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and in classroom for 'short' courses. Assessment decisions can be appealed.

The average course duration for **CPC20120 Certificate II in Construction** is 12 months.
