

RII30920 Certificate III in Civil Construction

Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of individuals working as skilled operators in civil construction, who apply a broad range of skills in varied work contexts, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge.

Course Delivery

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and in classroom block training at an Australian Training Management facility. Students will be required to complete student record books and unit specific logbooks.

Entry Requirements

All students will take a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) test during enrolment. This helps us offer any needed support. If you don't meet entry requirements, we'll connect you to support services.

All students must work in civil construction and hold a Construction White Card before training starts.

Course Duration

The average course duration for **RII30920 - Certificate III in Civil Construction (General)** is 36 months.

Fees

Funded: Students registered through a traineeship/apprenticeship pathway may be eligible for funding through the Jobs & Skills WA, lower Lees, Local Skills Program. Fees will depend on units selected. The student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment. Additional fees may apply such as student services and resource fees.
