This Roller Operator certification program provides information and guided practice that will equip experienced operators with the skills necessary to demonstrate competence to the minimum national certification standards (**NOHSC7019**) and to lay the foundation skills of new operators so that they can, in a safe manner, continue to improve their skills and proficiency whilst operating the machine.

DURATION

COURSE CONTENT

- Planning and preparing for operations
- Pre- and post-operational checks
- Start up and shut down procedures
- Vibrating rollers
- Static and multi-tyre rollers
- Compaction practices for road construction
- Roller patterns
- Density
- Operator maintenance
