What is this traineeship about?

RII30919 Certificate III in Civil Construction (Pipe Laying) is a nationally recognised qualification and reflects the role of a skilled operator working in civil construction, who applies a broad range of skills in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge.

To obtain this qualification you will require:

- 7 core units of competency
- 18 elective units (4 electives may be substituted from a relevant endorsed Training Package)

The selection of typical traineeship units is presented below.

Core Units – 7 units required

RIIBEF201D	Plan and organise work
RIICCM201D	Carry out measurements and calculations
RIICCM203D	Read and interpret plans and job specifications
RIICOM201E	Communicate in the workplace
RIISAM203D	Use hand and power tools
RIISAM204D	Operate small plant and equipment
RIIWHS201E	Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures



Electives – 18 units required

To be selected and agreed by RTO, employer and trainee at time of enrolment.

How is the course delivered?

This course is available by Australian Training Management as a registered traineeship qualification enrolled by an employer only. Participants who are employed either full-time or part-time for a minimum of 20 hours per week are eligible for this traineeship.

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and in classroom for 'short' courses. Assessment decisions can be appealed.

The average course duration for **RII30919 Certificate III in Civil Construction (Pipe Laying)** is 24 months.
