Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of individuals such as production operators, working in open cut coal or metalliferous mines or quarries, who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

Course Delivery

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and in classroom block training at an Australian Training Management facility. Students will be required to complete student record books and unit specific logbooks.

Entry Requirements

All students will take a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) test during enrolment. This helps us offer any needed support. If you don't meet entry requirements, we'll connect you to support services.

All students must work within the relevant industry.

Course Duration

The average course duration for **RII30120 - Certificate III Surface Extraction Operations** is 24 months.

Fees

Funded: Students registered through a traineeship/apprenticeship pathway may be eligible for funding through the Jobs & Skills WA, lower Lees, Local Skills Program. Fees will depend on units selected. The student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment.
