Electives – 5 units required

To be selected and agreed by RTO, employer and trainee at time of enrolment.

How is the course delivered?

This course is available by Australian Training Management as a registered traineeship qualification enrolled by an employer only. Participants who are employed either full-time or part-time for a minimum of 20 hours per week are eligible for this traineeship.

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and online training. Assessment decisions can be appealed.

The average course duration for RII31820 Certificate III in Drilling Operations is 24 months.
