## What is this traineeship about?

**RII31820 Certificate III in Drilling Operations** is designed for employees such as drillers who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications applied in a wide variety of contexts, which may involve application of some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

To obtain this qualification you will require:

- 8 core units of competency
- 5 elective units (2 electives may be substituted from a relevant endorsed Training Package)

The selection of typical traineeship units is presented below.

### Core Units – 8 units required

BSBWHS301	Maintain workplace safety
MSMENV172	Identify and minimise environmental hazards
RIIBEF301D	Run on-site operations
RIICOM301E	Communicate information
RIIERR302E	Respond to local emergencies and incidents
RIINHB301E	Set up and prepare for drilling operations
RIIRIS301E	Apply risk management processes
RIISAM209E	Carry out operational maintenance

### Electives – 5 units required

To be selected and agreed by RTO, employer and trainee at time of enrolment.

## How is the course delivered?

This course is available by Australian Training Management as a registered traineeship qualification enrolled by an employer only. Participants who are employed either full-time or part-time for a minimum of 20 hours per week are eligible for this traineeship.

Training and assessment will be a combination of on-site and online training. Assessment decisions can be appealed.

The average course duration for **RII31820 Certificate III in Drilling Operations** is 24 months.
